Welcome to the 34th Annual Harvestfest **AT YORK BEACH!**

- Harvestfest will be a **one-day event** on Saturday, October 13. The hours are **9:00am - 4:00pm**.
- **The price structure and vendor information has changed, please be sure to read all information carefully.**
- Railroad Avenue will remain open to one lane of traffic with police-manned pedestrian crossings throughout the festival.
- **Parking:** York's Wild Kingdom is again donating the use of their parking lots during the event providing easy access for festival-goers!
- **This is a rain or shine event.**
- More space and opportunities for our food vendors, now located along the tree line at the back side of the Ballfield outside of the fence area on the pavement. Providing additional seating for diners throughout the Ballfield. Great for families!
- **Juried Crafters are not able to drive on the Ballfield** for set-up at anytime. Please plan ahead to transport your products onto the field with carts or dollies.
- **Early check-in/set-up: Come early!** Check-in & set-up available Friday, 2:00pm to 5:00pm. Please do not arrive before 2:00pm. All vendors must be completely setup and ready to leave the event grounds by 5:00pm. (No Exceptions)

- **Regular Check-in:** The morning of the event at 7:00am, NOT before that time. No one may be on the Ballfield or in the Wild Kingdom area before that time.

Please review the enclosed map* and select your preferred sites. Enter the numbers on the enclosed application and mail it back to us ASAP with your check or credit card account information. The spaces will be awarded on a first come/first served basis. **Past participation does not guarantee a booth spot.**

- Juried Craft spaces will be located in the York Beach Ballfield on the grass.
- Old Fashioned Market (buy/sell products) will be located in the parking lot across from the York Beach fire station and adjacent to the entrance to York's Wild Kingdom on the pavement.

JURIED CRAFTERS: In the Ballpark

Products juried by selection committee. The committee has the right to refuse any vendor. Acceptance is based on originality, creativity, general appeal and quality of craft and booth design. Purchase of a booth space does **not** guarantee exclusivity of your product type. Types of products accepted:

- Art, craft and hobby work items of original design and completely handcrafted by YOU.
- Pre-packaged food items made in a licensed kitchen by the vendor (ex: dips, candy, sauces, etc)

No manufactured or imported items are allowed. This will be strictly enforced.

Vendors who did not participate last year or whose products have changed: 4 photographs must be submitted including one of your work space/studio.

OLD FASHIONED MARKET: In paved lot at the zoo entrance, across from the fire station

Open to all products with Chamber approval. Can re-sell products in this section. No “novelty items” as listed below.

New vendors: 4 photographs must be submitted.

The following “novelty items” will not be allowed at the festival:

Noise-makers; clackers; fire-crackers; cap-shooters; knives, swords or guns of ANY kind; lighters; ANYTHING that shocks. This is a **no tolerance policy** - if a staff member sees any of these types of items, you will leave the festival immediately with no refund.

RULES FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS: Only completed applications will be processed.

- Spaces are approximately 10' x 10'. **Tents and displays must be located entirely within the assigned space.** You will need to supply ALL needed supplies for your space including tents, tables, chairs, etc. **We reserve the right to relocate and reassign spaces without notice** although we will make every effort to accommodate requests. Electricity is NOT available for craft vendors.
- **Juried Crafters cannot drive on the Ballfield** for set-up at anytime. Please plan ahead to transport your products onto the field with carts or dollies.
- All tents, merchandise and personal belongings left overnight are at your own risk. We do not patrol the area. Harvestfest and the Chamber of Commerce accepts no responsibility for items lost, stolen or damaged.
- **Tents must be adaptable to lawn or hard-topped surfaces and equipped with weights and stakes in case of wind.**
- We reserve the right to deny participation to vendors whose merchandise is deemed inappropriate and not in keeping with the theme. See the list above for unacceptable products.
- No commercial carts, trucks, etc. are allowed at Harvestfest.
- No beverages may be sold & each pre-packaged food item must be pre-approved for sale. Selling food items of any kind like packaged candy, herb dips, bbq sauce, etc. require the vendor to provide a certificate of insurance.
- Harvestfest is a smoke-free, dog-free and balloon-free festival and we ask everyone to comply with this, including vendors.
- The Chamber makes the final decision about ALL products being sold.
- **ALL APPLICATIONS must include the license plate number for the vehicle that you will have at the festival. Only one vehicle per vendor space is allowed. Other vehicles will not be permitted to enter the vendor loading areas and must be parked in the Wild Kingdom parking lot. You must unload, and immediately move vehicle to the assigned Vendor Parking area & then set-up your booth. Vehicles parked in the loading areas will be towed at owners expense.**
- All booth fees are deposited upon receipt, therefore cancelled checks do not mean acceptance.
- **All vendors applications must include a \$35 check for Booth Space Clean Up Fee.** Harvestfest is a carry in, carry out event. Vendors are not permitted to leave boxes, paper, food, broken equipment, or trash of any kind on the ground or around booth spaces. The dumpster and trash cans are not to be used for vendor trash. Your booth must be inspected before you leave the event. Uninspected booths automatically forfeit the \$35 Clean Up Fee. If your space has been cleaned up, your \$35 Clean Up Fee will be returned or voided.
